The hotel has very nice rooms, two restaurants, a mini Starbucks and of course there is the King of Prussia mall which is the second largest in the US. The Elmwood Park Zoo is nearby as is Valley Forge Park, and Valley Forge Casino Resort. The hotel provides shuttle service to the local area and also to the Norristown SEPTA train station. While most arriving by plane will probably rent a car you could, with a change of trains, get from the airport to the Norristown station via SEPTA.
